

Activities based on I Samuel 15:34-16:13, Psalm 20, 2 Corinthians 5:6-10, (11-13), 14-17, Mark 4:26-34.





In I Samuel, God asks the prophet Samuel to select the next King — King David. He is a young boy at the time and no one expected him to be chosen! What God thinks is important is sometimes different from what we do. Draw a picture of someone you see as a good leader with a loving heart.

FINISH THE DRAWING
